1) GENERAL POLICY STATEMENT

The School of Medicine considers confidentiality of student evaluations as an essential element in creating a proper learning environment. Educational records are covered by FERPA and protection of sensitive materials is a matter of federal law. Grades and narrative description of student performance are never to be displayed publicly, left out in an open environment, posted to a public website, or emailed to individual students or groups of students.

Grades are to be entered into the electronic student information system (Banner®) by the Department responsible for the grade. Narrative assessments cannot be emailed to individual students and must be entered directly into BOX® for each individual student.

Students have continual electronic access to grades and narratives

- a) **Scope:** This policy applies to grades and narratives for all medical students.
- b) **Responsible Department/Party/Parties:**
 - i. Policy Owner: Office of Admissions and Student Affairs
 - ii. Procedure: Office of Admissions and Student Affairs/Registrar
 - iii. Supervision: Office of Admissions and Student Affairs
