- 2. Open discussion and Q&A.
- 3. Case presentations and management strategies, including approaches to complex cases or adverse events.

Meetings are expected to occur once a month, scheduled on weekday evenings for about an hour. All robotic surgeons in Louisiana, across medical schools, teaching programs, and private practices, are encouraged to participate and contribute.

This statewide, multi-institutional initiative is designed to foster communication, support professional growth, and strengthen collaboration in robotic surgery across Louisiana.
