I have started several new rotations during my tenure at the Veterans Health Administration. Overall, I would estimate that I have worked with approximately 1,200 graduated medical students on a personal basis.

During my tenure since 2011, I have worked with 42 graduated PM&R residents and numerous others of varying specialties.
