

Scheduling/Elective Suggestions for DERM Specialty

***Rotations highlighted in a given color can be swapped for other time periods of the same color**

Major schedule considerations:

- Do you still need to take Step 1? Must take Step 1 by 8/15 or you will be placed on administrative LOA until you achieve a passing score.
- Do you need a T3 clerkship? Must complete before any T4 rotation.
- Do you need free time to study for Step 2? Most students use 2 - 4 weeks of vacation time; most take Step 2 in May/June. Take no later than December.
- Do you want a rotation to appear on your ERAS application materials? Complete it in August or earlier: September may be a stretch. ERAS info will be available to residency programs sometime in late Sept/early Oct (exact date TBA by AAMC).
- Have you planned free time during interview season? Generally Nov – Jan. Even virtual interviews are stressful—give yourself free time if possible!
- Have you completed all graduation requirements? See tables on last page for guide. Complete all requirements by last block of April for best outcome. Only in extenuating circumstances should graduating students plan to work after graduation.

Residency paperwork cannot be completed until all graduation requirements are complete and you are certified for graduation.

After initial scheduling appointment, send all permission/requests for add/drops to SOMSchedule@tulane.edu. Forward dept permission & indicate rotation (*i.e.*, MED4230 Gastro) and start/end dates for all adds/drops. Allow at least one week before you follow up. For your sanity, plan permanently, and send as few schedule change requests as possible! **No schedule changes are made less than 7 days before a block begins.**

	Required Rotations (must be scheduled before your appt is complete. Consider your required rotation schedule permanent unless under extreme extenuating circumstances. Cannot drop one section w/o dept permission to both drop and also add another specific section.)	
1	Acting internship (XXXX3500 or XXXX4500): 4 wks (<i>can be scheduled later, can be dropped/moved, but only into gaps or elective slots; cannot drop required rotations to rearrange</i>)	
2	Community Health (MED4212): 2 wks (not required for MD/MPH)	
3	Emergency (EMER4020): 2 wks	
4	Radiology (RADS3020): 2 wks
