## HISTORY

TUSOM celebrated its 175th anniversary in 2009. It is the second oldest medical school in the South and the 15th oldest medical school in the United States. TUSOM employs approximately 400 full-time faculty (the current faculty is larger than the pre-Katrina faculty). TUSOM maintains more than 20 community student-run clinics throughout New Orleans, providing quality healthcare to the underserved population.

### DeBakey and Leone Educational Center

- » Designed to facilitate Team-Based Learning (TBL).
- » Each contains the latest in multi-media presentation equipment and sound, is filled with tables of six and is surrounded by 15, 65 inch LCD flat screens, and two large Smartboards™.

### Tulane Center for Advanced Medical Simulation & Team Training (Sim Center)

- » Designed to train students, residents, and faculty using both high fidelity simulators as well as Crew Resource Management (team training).
- » Enables all healthcare professionals, medical students, nursing students, residents, nurses, faculty physicians and technicians to practice and perfect technique in a safe environment.

### Goldring Teaching Kitchen

- » Designed to educate physicians, residents and partnering culinary students.
- » Features a state-of-the-art kitchen and onsite garden to better understand the impact of diet on health and the role of nutrition in disease prevention.

### Innovation Center

- » Designed to foster exchange of ideas throughout the Tulane community.
- » Houses Technology Commercialization Seminar Series and students can be part of patent applications, making it the only one of it's kind in the United States.



## STUDENT CENTER

- » Two locations: on the 6th Floor of the Murphy Building and the 1st Floor of the Hutch Building.
- » Provides opportunity for study and relaxation.
- » Includes small group study rooms, kitchen, computer work station, TVs, ping-pong table, and pool table.
- » Student Fitness Center: exercise equipment includes weight machines, free weights, treadmills, saunas and locker rooms.
