1) GENERAL POLICY STATEMENT

1. The School of Medicine has a single grading standard for all students for promotion and graduation. Regardless of the location that a student completes a clinical rotation, grades are determined by the respective Departments in the School of Medicine based on guidelines approved by the Curriculum Committee.
2. Graduation standards are established by faculty serving as representatives on relevant committees (Student Professionalism and Promotion Committee, Curriculum Committee, etc) and approved by the Executive Faculty. All students eligible for graduation are reviewed by the Committee on Student Professionalism and Promotion who recommends graduation to the Executive Faculty. The Executive Faculty approves all students for graduation.

a) Scope: This policy applies to all medical students.

3) Review/Revision/Implementation

- a) Review Cycle: This policy shall be reviewed by the Curriculum Committee at least annually from the effective date.
- b) Office of Record: After authorization, the Dean’s Office Office of Student Affairs) shall be the office of record for this policy.
