- e) UMC ED Entrance Updates:

- i) In light of UMC discussion with residents, they are working towards operationalizing a badge access entrance at the side door adjacent to the guarded ED entrance.
- ii) Initial assessment of the side door revealed that the door is currently not electrified and will need hardware installed.
- iii) UMC facilities team is determining the lead time in obtaining the appropriate hardware and they will report back. Depending on lead time, they will evaluate all other options that help expedite making that pathway accessible.
